We will always keep you informed about the security of your account.

This may look like an official request, but it's not. We will never ask you for your password, nor will our lenders. Request to confirm or change passwords will always happen when you are logging into their site, not by an email request that takes you to a different site. Also, never just hit reply!

Read, Hover, Call

Read; Does it really make sense. For instance, I am an IT person and I receive a request to wire funds; Flagstar sends you a request and the site is not https:// (secure server is being used).

Hover; When you hover over a link it will show you where it came from or where you will be sending your information to. So, in the case of the email above if you clicked on the link to "Confirm Password" you would be sending your password to "sophiz.biz"
